6 YOUNG MEN FROM LOW INCOME DISADVANTAGE COMMUNITIES IN INNER CITY KNOXVILLE STARTED THEIR LEADERSHIP JOURNEY IN OUR RESIDENTIAL LIVING QUARTER, PENULT PLACE IN JEFFERSON CITY TN.

Year One Outcome & Program Updates- The inaugural 2019-20 class of participants graduated from the program last summer and are in college or working full time jobs. The current class (2nd Cohort) started January 2021 and two more came on board this summer. The planned start date was mid-August 2020 but due to Youth Serving Agencies program closures and COVID restrictions we started the current class at the beginning of the year (January 2021). All program participants are working full time jobs while completing a series of workshop, seminars, and activities; learning the essentials values and skills they need to be successful personally, spiritually, and professionally. Each week participants learned from experts and community leaders in the areas of education, business, engineering, welding, construction, manufacturing, defense, law enforcement, entrepreneurship, architecture, technology, coaching, ministry, music, banking, and human resources. All of the participants are working towards success and selfsufficiency despite the new set of obstacles and challenges brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic.

One of the participants Darrell Willis completed an internship with a local architect and works periodically on big projects, Tylan Redic is in a training program to become a certified tire technician with a regional tire center and serving in the local National Coast Guard Reserve, and Isaiah Story is excelling in his job being selected as the employee of the month in March 2021 and won a perfect attendance award since being employed at Premiere Maintenance-Carson Newman Campus.



Having the opportunity to work with these young men has been one of my greatest pleasures.... Life is ultimately about serving and giving back. What Diondre poured into me over the years I now have the chance to pour into guys who grew up in the same community as me. My hope is that what we're doing creates a ripple effect for generations to come.
